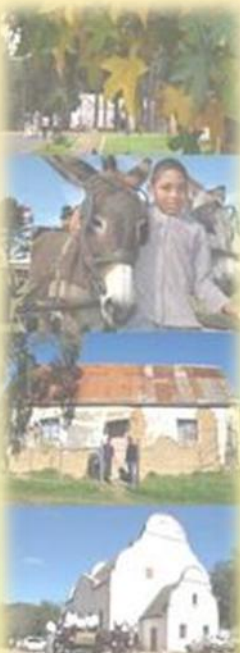


# The Mamre Donkey Trail



The Mamre Donkey Trail project is a community initiative supported by the Claremont Rotary Club, CREW and Touching Earth Lightly. The project aims to develop and sustain the tourism industry in Mamre. The Donkey trail was designed to include historical, cultural and biodiversity aspects into one product. Through strengthening the tourism industry we can create awareness and appreciation for the incredibly special biodiversity of the area. The success of our tourism initiative will depend of the protection and sustainable management of the astonishing biological resources and as well the rich historical heritage of the area.

The tour aims to showcase the exceptionally rich historical, cultural and biological heritage of this wonderful town on the West Coast. Visitors are taken on a scenic guided tour of the town where our local tour guides will share their knowledge and passionate stories of life in Mamre. The tour ends with a scrumptious three course home cooked meal at the historical Moravian church grounds.

**Basic itinerary :**

- Arrival and Welcome (10 mins)
- Brief introduction to the tour (10 mins)
- Donkey cart ride through town experiencing the cultural diversity of the town and viewing some historical buildings (30mins)
- Walking tour of the Mamre Moravian Church grounds and the historical buildings (45m ins)
- Sit down three course meal at the "Old Restaurant" (60 mins)
- Optional: Donkey cart ride to Mamre Nature Garden and walk through the fynbos (60 mins)
